



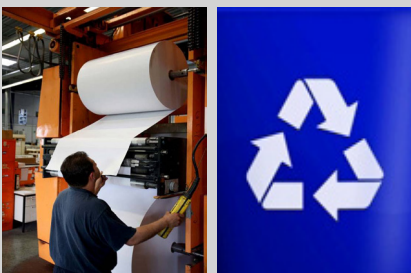

Alabama
