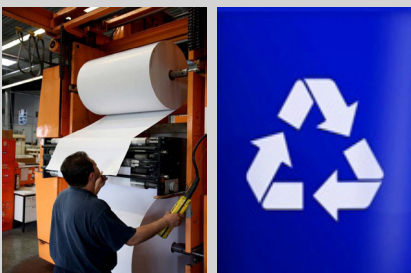




Mississippi
